Election Campaign Underway

As you know, last Friday the Taoiseach was granted a dissolution of the Dail and the general election campaign is well and truly underway with polling taking place on Friday, 29 November next.

The campaign provides apartment owners and residents with an opportunity to ensure that the next Dáil tackles the much-needed reform of the owners' management company (OMC) sector and completes the vital work of sorting out defects.

In order to drive this forward effectively, the Construction Defects Alliance and the MUD Act Reform Group are working together to ensure maximum impact on candidates running for election as well as their parties and groupings.
